**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that the Chairperson and Secretary of the Planning Board are authorized and directed to enter into a Contract for such professional legal services with Adam Telsey, Esq.; and,


**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that the awarding of a contract to Adam Telsey, Esq. to serve as Solicitor and to provide various legal services has been made without competitive bidding in accordance with the provisions of the Local Public Contract Law because the same calls for specially qualified professional legal services; and,


**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that notice of the awarding of this contract without competitive bids shall be published in accordance with the provision of the Local
