a subdivision. The property is an existing farm and is designated as agricultural.

Mr. Salber wore in Wayde Allen who stated that the whole farm is farmland preserved and owned by A&R Farms, LLC. Their intent is to continue farming and that no new roads are proposed. Two farmers own the farm and want to divide, plain and simple.

Katie B. Coleman, Esq., attorney for applicant, inquired about the return of the fees. Mr. DiVietro stated that there would be some fees incurred as the professionals have invested time in the review of the application and that there would be a minimal amount of fees incurred to review the Deeds, once they have been presented.

The Board members were asked to give their thoughts on the return of the fees, minus the professional's fees and the Board members stated that the fees should be returned.

The action that the Board needs to vote on regarding hearing the testimony of the applicants, it is an agricultural which meets the criteria for an agricultural subdivision.
