A RESOLUTION APPOINTING <u>Richard P. Coe Jr., Esq.</u> AS CONFLICT SOLICITOR AND AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP OF QUINTON TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES FOR THE YEAR 2024

WHEREAS, there exists the need for a solicitor to provide legal services to the Quinton Township Planning Board; and

WHEREAS, such services are "professional services" as defined in the Local Public Contracts Law ($\underline{\text{N.J.S.A.}}$ 40A:11-1 et. seq.) and are not required to be advertised for competitive bids;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Quinton Township Planning Board as follows:

- 1. That <u>Richard P. Coe Jr., Esq.</u> be and hereby is appointed to serve as the Quinton Township Planning Board Conflict Solicitor for the year 2024;
- 2. That the Chairperson and Secretary be hereby authorized and directed to execute an agreement with <u>Richard P. Coe Jr., Esq.</u> to serve as Planning Board Conflict Solicitor for a one (1) year term commencing on January 1st, 2024 and ending on December 31st, 2024;
- 3. That this contract be awarded without competitive bidding as a "professional service" under the provisions of the Local Public Contracts Law, because <u>Richard P. Coe Jr., Esq.</u> is authorized by law to practice a recognized profession, namely, Attorney-At-Law;

4. That notice of this Resolution be made available in the <u>South Jersey Times</u> and <u>Elmer Times</u> within ten (10) days of its passage as required by law.
