R9- Tier A Municipal Stormwater General Permit

Hazard of Illicit Connection and Improper Disposal of Waste

Notice to all Businesses and Residents of the Township of Quinton:

To be compliant with Tier A Municipal Stormwater General Permit issued by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP), municipalities are required to educate businesses and residents on the hazards of illicit connections and improper disposal of waste.

What is Illicit Connection?

Illicit connection means any physical or non-physical connection that discharges domestic sewage, non-contact cooling water, process wastewater, or other industrial waste (other than stormwater) to the municipal separate storm sewer system operated by the Township of Quinton, unless that discharge is authorized under a NJPDES permit other than the Tier A Municipal Stormwater General Permit (NJPDES Permit Number NJ0141852). Non-physical connections may include, but are not limited to, leaks, flows, or overflows into the municipal separate storm sewer system.

What is Improper Disposal of Waste?

Improper disposal of waste includes spilling, dumping or disposal of materials other than stormwater to the municipal separate storm sewer system operated by the Township of Quinton.

Illicit connection and improper disposal of waste can lead to serious environmental and public health problems by introducing pollutants into waterways, impacting water quality and aquatic life. Both are strictly prohibited.
