AUTHORIZING STREET OPENING PERMIT FOR ATLANTIC CITY ELECTRIC

WHEREAS, Atlantic City Electric has requested a Street Opening Permit for Block 23 Lot 1; and

WHEREAS, Atlantic City Electric has completed a Street Opening Permit which has been reviewed by the Township Engineer, Fralinger Engineering and is herein attached; and

WHEREAS, the Township Engineer has set forth the amounts necessary for the Street Opening Permit and inspection fees; and
