

**QUINTON TOWNSHIP 2026**  
**TRASH & RECYCLING Regulations**

Per Quinton Township Ordinance, a limit of one (1) trash cart and one (1) recycling cart will be issued upon each property's *initial* certificate of occupancy. All receptacle carts shall be issued initially by the Township of Quinton and shall remain the property of the Township of Quinton. Upon any change of ownership or occupant, all such receptacle carts shall remain with the property. The property owner and/or occupant is responsible for the replacement of any damaged, stolen, or missing receptacles. The replacement must be purchased from the Township of Quinton, and the fee is \$75 per receptacle cart. The fee shall be paid by cash or check at the Clerk's office.

**Recyclables** are single-streamed (all recyclables should be in one container). Recyclables are identified as aluminum, tin, glass, plastic #1 and #2, narrow-neck containers, clean cardboard, newspaper, and non-glossy paper. *\*Plastic bags and Shredded paper are not recyclables and should go in the trash.*

**Please note the following:**

- *All trash and recyclables will be picked up every Thursday*
- *All trash and recyclables must be in receptacle carts, with lids closed*
- *All trash, bulk, and recyclables must be at the curb by 6:00 AM and must be removed from curbside within 48 hours if not picked up on scheduled trash day.*
- *During a holiday week (Monday through Saturday), your trash and recycling may be collected up to one full day earlier or later than your regular service day.*

**Syringes** may be disposed of in your regular trash by breaking off the needle and placing the entire contents (syringe and needle) in a plastic container before disposing of the plastic container in the trash.

**Empty Paint Cans** containing water-based paints, up to five (5) cans, may be disposed of in regular trash. Over five (5) cans, a bulk sticker must be purchased for bulk pickup. *\*Oil-based paint, if empty, may go in regular trash. If not, then they must be disposed of at the Solid Waste Facility on Hazardous Collection Day.*

**Building & Construction Materials** will not be collected; contractors/ residents are responsible for disposing.

**PLEASE NOTE THAT IF YOU DO NOT RECYCLE, YOU MAY BE FINED UP TO \$1,000.00**

Per Township Ordinance, it is illegal to permit anyone to remove any recyclable materials from curbside.

**SPECIALTY ITEMS**

**Bulk Trash Stickers** can be purchased in the Clerk's office with cash or check for \$5.00. You **MUST CALL** by 12:00 pm Thursday before bulk pickup to be added to the pickup route. Clerk's office 856-935-2325 x2

**Bulk Trash Items:** Furniture, Mattresses/Box Spring, Bed Frame, Table and Chair, Rug, Window, Bathtub, Vanity Sink, Toilet, Door, Refrigerator, Freezer, Furnace, Hot Water Tank, Washer/ Dryer, Freezer, Microwave, Disassembled Swing Set, Exercise Equipment, Push Mower, Air Conditioner Unit, and BBQ Grill. **NO Auto/ Auto parts, Lawn Mowers, TV, Computer Monitor, Copier, Printer, Hazard Waste, or Chemicals will be collected.**

*Only 3 large items at a time will be taken.*

- *All items other than furniture must not be more than 4 ft. in length.*
- *Items not picked up must be removed from the curbside within 48 hrs.*
- *If you move, all bulk trash must be gone before you move.*
- *Bulk Goods must be out by the curb BEFORE 6 AM on the third Monday of the month.*

**Salem County Convenience Center** (52 McKillip Road & 540, Alloway Township), open Wednesdays and Saturdays, 8 AM to 3 PM, County residents *only*, with a driver's license and ID, are eligible to deposit trash

and recycling. Residents can call the Convenience Center at 856-935-7900 for fees, made payable by cash or credit card *only*. All trash must be covered; tarps are available for free at the Quinton Township Municipal Building.

**Electronic Equipment: TV, Computer Monitor, Copier, Printer, etc.** *May be disposed of for free. Please make sure the equipment is not broken into parts and the cord is intact (not cut).*

**Hazardous Waste Collection** April 18 and October 17, 2025, 8 am to 12 Noon, pesticides must be taken to the landfill on Hazardous Waste Day.

**Paper Shredding Event** Salem County Improvement Authority hosts FREE Paper Shredding Events for residents; contact SCIA at (856)935-7900 or visit their website at scianj.com for upcoming dates and times.

- Limit is 3 standard boxes per person (not per car).
- Shredded paper can be placed in plastic or paper bags using a standard box size for measurement.

*Leaves, Grass Clippings, Latex & Water-Based Paint, Explosives, and Shock-Sensitive Chemicals will not be accepted by the Salem County Convenience Center. Please call (856) 935-7900 with any questions.*

### **OTHER**

**Christmas Trees** devoid of decoration will be accepted by The Quinton Township Garage (18 New Street, Quinton, N.J.) during January for proper disposal.

**Free Rabies Clinic** will be held on February 7, 2026, from 1 PM to 3 PM at the Quinton Fire House.

**Dog Licenses** are required by New Jersey State law. A license will only be granted upon proof of a valid rabies vaccination valid through November 1, 2026, for a one (1) year license and November 1, 2028, for a 3-year license. Proof of spaying/neutered must also be presented. A late fee of \$20.00 for each dog begins March 1, 2026. (see yellow insert for more information)

**Wood Chipper Service** is available for residents during the first week of the month of April, May, June, September, and October, weather permitting. Services are limited to the one-acre surrounding the house, and only tree branches are permitted. Branches should not be longer than six (6) feet and no larger than four (4) inches in diameter. A limit of two (2) 4x4x6ft piles per residence. Tree branches should be placed in a neat pile, near the curbside, with the butt end toward the road. Please do not include any vines, roots, grass clippings, yard debris, or bushes. All severe trimming and tree removals must be contracted by the owner and removal at the owner's expense.

**Halloween** trick-or-treat hours are 4 PM to 7 PM on October 31, 2026

**Leaf Pickup** – Begins week of Thanksgiving 2026 (Weather Permitting) Leaf collection will take place only in areas with storm drains. The designated pickup areas include:

- Elk Terrace
- Quinton Village Streets: New, Sickler (from Rt. 49 to New), Smithfield, Robinson, Main (from Rt. 581 to the school entrance), and High
- Quinton Village Avenues: Lake, East, and Cottage
- Quinton-Alloway Road: Approximately 9/10 miles down from Rt. 49

**South Jersey Agricultural Products** (210 Newkirk Station Road, Elmer), open Monday through Friday, 8:00 AM to 3:00 PM, accepts leaves, brush, and grass clippings. Residents can call South Jersey Agricultural Products for fees at 856-358-1362 or 856-368-0156.
