ORDINANCE NO. 2025-12**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 170 OF THE CODE OF
THE TOWNSHIP OF QUINTON
TO AMEND AND RECONCILE INCONSISTENCIES IN CHAPTER 170-61**

WHEREAS, the Township of Quinton, Salem County, in Ordinance 2025-05 amended its municipal code to enhance the functionality and flexibility of its Planning Board; and

WHEREAS, in the course of so doing, portions of Chapter 170-61 were not amended, leaving inconsistencies in the recitations regarding the number of alternates;

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Quinton deems it in the best interest of the Township to amend Chapter 170.61 to clarify the number of alternates and remove any inconsistencies in the Code of Quinton Township;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Quinton, County of Salem, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. Purpose

The purpose of this Ordinance is to amend Chapter 170 -61 of the Code of Quinton Township to remove inconsistencies and clarify the number of alternates

Section 2.

Amendment to Chapter 170.61 (A)

Chapter 170.61 (A) of the Code of the Township of Quinton is hereby amended to read as follows (deletions are stricken and additions are underlined).:

- A. There is hereby established in Quinton Township a Planning Board of nine members and ~~two~~ four alternates, consisting of the following four classes pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:55D-23:
- (1) Class I: the Mayor.
 - (2) Class II: one of the officials of the municipality, other than a member of the governing body, to be appointed by the Mayor.
 - (3) Class III: a member of the governing body to be appointed by it.
 - (4) Class IV: six other citizens of the municipality to be appointed by the Mayor as regular members and ~~two~~ four other citizens, appointed by the Mayor as alternates.

Section 2. Severability

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this ordinance.

Section 3. Repealer

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 4. Effective Date

This ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication as required by law.
