AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF QUINTON TO ADD
ARTICLE III "GENERAL PENALTIES" TO PART 1 "ADMINISTRATIVE LEGISLATION"
CHAPTER 1 "GENERAL PROVISIONS"

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40:49-5 authorizes the governing body of a municipality to prescribe a general penalty for the violation of ordinances;

WHEREAS, the Code of the Township of Quinton does not presently have a general penalty that applies to violations of Township Ordinances

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Quinton deems it in the best interests of the public and residents of Quinton Township to have a general penalty in its code;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Quinton, County of Salem and State of New Jersey, to add Article III "General Penalties" to Part 1 "Administrative Legislation" Chapter 1 "General Provisions" of the municipal code of the Township of Quinton. Chapter 1 is amended to add (addition is underlined):

Section 1: Chapter 1 is amended to add:

Article III. General Penalties

- §3-1 Maximum penalty. Unless otherwise provided by law, any person, firm or corporation who violates any provision of this Code or any other ordinance of the Borough where no specific penalty is provided shall, upon conviction, be subject to a fine not exceeding \$2,000, a term of imprisonment not exceeding 90 days or a period of community service not exceeding 90 days, or any combination thereof.
- §3-2 Separate violations. Except as otherwise provided, every day in which a violation of any provision of this Code or any other ordinance of the borough exists shall constitute a separate violation.

- 83-3 Application. The maximum penalty stated in this section is not intended to state an appropriate penalty for every violation. Any lesser penalty, including a nominal penalty or no penalty at all, may be appropriate for a particular case or violation.
- 83-3 Minimum penalty. The Township Committee may prescribe that, for the violation of any particular Code provision or ordinance, at least a minimum penalty shall be imposed which shall consist of a fine which may be fixed at an amount not exceeding \$100 (N.J.S.A. 40:49-5).

Section 2. Repealer

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

Section 3. Severability



Section 4. Effective Date


BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication as required by law.
